The Mary Elizabeth McGrath Educational Center is a Department of Education Special Education approved school, grades 7-12. McGrath is one of two campuses of the Y.O.U., Inc., Educational Day Program. It is located in Millbury, MA. Students are referred to McGrath for emotional, behavioral, and/or learning disabilities that have interfered with their ability to progress in a less restrictive setting. Referral agencies include school districts, Department of Youth Services, Department of Social Services, or any other agency with public school district approval.

A myriad of educational and clinical services are provided at the McGrath campus. All academic courses are aligned with the Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks. Academic course offerings are supplemented by a vocational program including culinary arts, computer instruction, and visual/graphic arts. Classrooms feature a low staff to student ratio with class curriculum individualized to the students learning style as is outlined in his/her Individualized Educational Plan (IEP).

Master level clinicians provide clinical services with an emphasis on psycho-educational group work. Additionally, all students participate in weekly individual and group counseling. Family counseling is scheduled as needed. Individualized clinical treatment plans are developed for each student. Additional services provided at McGrath include Occupational Therapy, MCAS preparation, adventure-based learning, educational and functional-behavioral assessments.
